

# Columbia County Transportation System Plan Update: Public Open House

## What is the Transportation System Plan?

The Transportation System Plan (TSP) provides a long term guide to County transportation investments. The plan evaluates the current transportation system and determines how it could be improved to make travel in Columbia County better.

Columbia County is beginning the process to identify opportunities to improve our current transportation system and forecast what it may look like through 2035. We need your help discussing priorities given limited transportation funding.
